Munganin Gadhaba (Achieve Together) artwork commission

The Department of Environment Land Water and Planning (DELWP) invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from artists to participate in a project to create an artwork that represents a unique DELWP Aboriginal Cultural Identity.

The *Munganin Gadhaba* artwork project is a two-stage process to potentially commission an artist to create an artwork that responds to the theme of "Recognition and Respect", representing a unique DELWP Aboriginal Identity, and reflecting DELWP's genuine partnership with Victorian Traditional Owners.

The artwork should demonstrate either one or a combination of the following elements:

- Coming together and caring for Country
- Aboriginal people and their daily connection to Country
- Deep respect for Aboriginal culture
- Unification for all Aboriginal Victorians
- The pride you feel as an Aboriginal person
- A celebration of culture
- Collaboration with Aboriginal Victorians and other Australians
- The possum skin design; and
- The Victorian landscape, including fire, trees, water, native wildlife and Aboriginal heritage.
