### The proposed future act

Parks Victoria is proposing works to upgrade the Wilsons Promontory Wildlife Walk including the extension of the existing carparking area, extension of walking track, compacted gravel track topping and the installation of several seats along the walk.

The upgrade works will improve the visitor experience and provide better access to visitors.

#### Works proposed include:

- The construction of three formal accessible car parking bays, topped with compacted gravel.
- Extension to the existing Wildlife Walk and topping the track with compacted gravel.
- The installation of signage and seating along the walk.

Wilsons Promontory National Park was reserved for the purpose of a national park before December 1996. The Prom was first reserved in 1898, with various additional areas added at times until 1969. Since 1975, the park has been included in Schedule Two of the *National Parks Act 1975*. The proposed upgrade works are in accordance with the purpose of the reservation.

The proposed construction of the carpark extension and track upgrade are considered to constitute the establishment of public works under Part 15, Division 4, Section 253 of the *Native Title Act 1993*.



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#### The future act is valid

The proposed activity is a valid future act pursuant to Section 24JA of the Native Title Act 1993.

Subdivision J of the Native Title Act 1993 allows for acts to be carried out on reserved land provided that the act is in good faith with the purpose of the reservation, or of no greater impact. Where the act involves the construction of a public work, (which extinguishes native title rights and interests), it is necessary that formal procedural notice be given to any registered claimant and to any registered Representative Body.

The proposed works are to be carried out over land that was validly reserved prior to 23 December 1996. The future act is in accordance with the purpose of the reservation.

The extinguishment principle applies to the footprint of the works only.
