Role Purpose

The Major Projects Senior Manager – Economic Development, will provide strategic leadership and planning to deliver a major projects development program. This position will focus on the renewable energy transition, including major onshore and offshore renewable energy infrastructure and the decommissioning and rehabilitation of old energy infrastructure on Gunaikurnai Country.

The role will develop and deliver strategic objectives and programs to achieve benefits from the renewable energy transition in Gippsland for GLaWAC and the Gunaikurnai community. The role is responsible for leading and developing a team to deliver and manage renewable energy programs. These programs align with the Gunaikurnai Whole of Country Plan and related strategies, and Gunaikurnai community aspirations.

The role will support activities to contribute to the development and delivery of a range of projects in line with Aboriginal Economic Development strategies.
